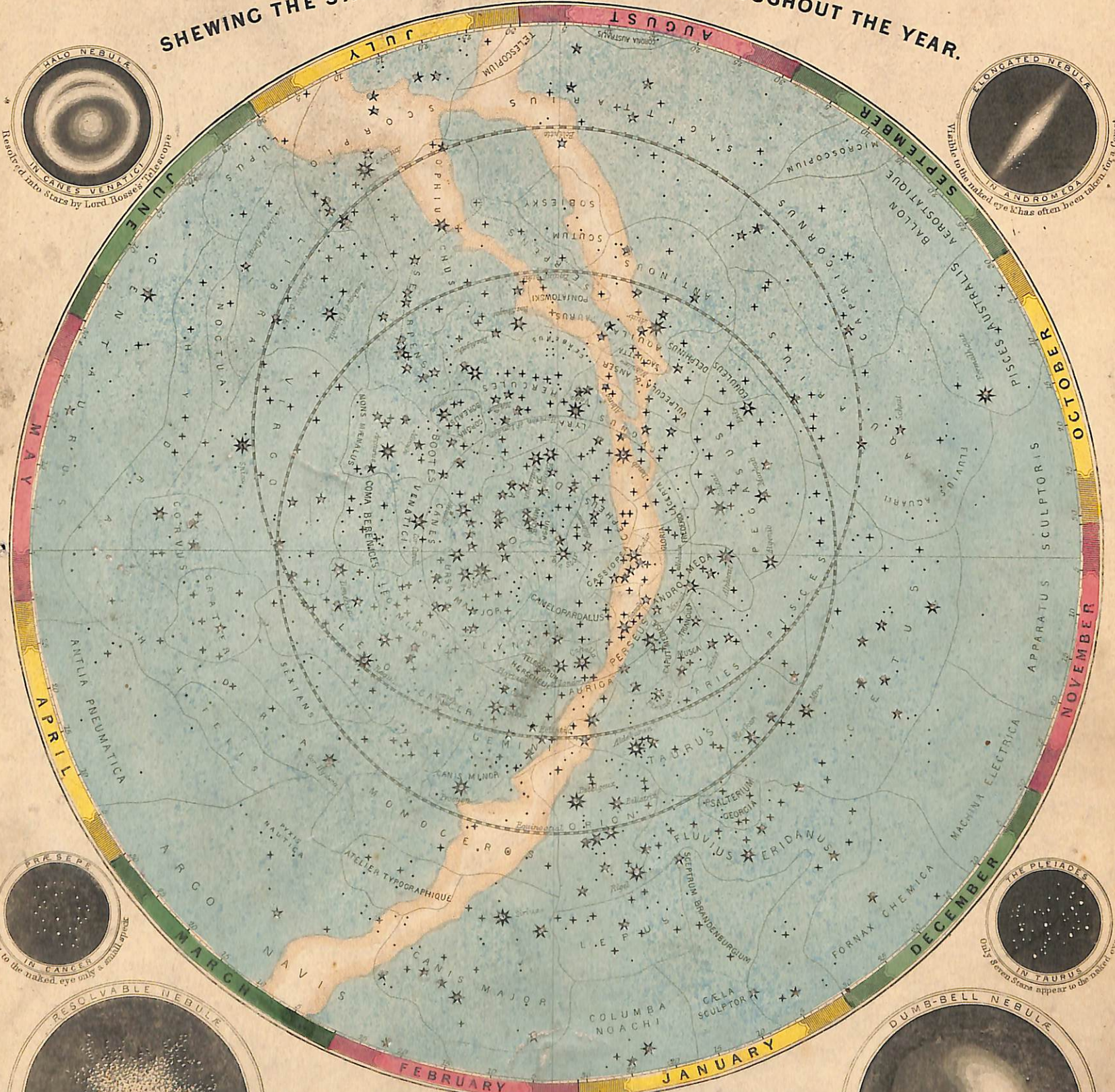


CHART OF THE HEAVENS

SHEWING THE STARS VISIBLE ON ANY NIGHT THROUGHOUT THE YEAR.



MAGNITUDES 1st 2nd 3rd 4th 5th OF THE STARS

DIRECTIONS

Find the day of the Month on the outer circle and the stars in a straight line with it, and the Pole-star in the centre will be on the meridian, or south, at nine o'clock in the evening, the relative positions of the other stars and constellations may then be readily traced.
Nebulae of which a few representations are here given, are considered to be sidereal firmaments each as expansive as that surrounding our system, but compressed by their immeasurable remoteness into a space, which at the largest to the naked eye, a snow-flake will utterly conceal
